NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and commitments set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the Parties agree as follows:

DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this MoU, the following terms shall have the meanings assigned to them:

- 1.1 "MoU" means this Memorandum of Understanding and any schedules, annexures or addenda hereto.

- **Technology Partner:** OLatus Systems Private Limited
- **Eligibility:** Currently enrolled students of the Institution
- **Type:** Practical, Project-Based and Industry-Oriented
- **Assessment:** As per program design; may include assignments, projects and/or evaluations
- **Certification:** Certificates issued by Gyantrika Foundation upon successful completion

JOB FAIR & INDUSTRY CONNECT

The Parties may collaborate for the following industry interaction and placement activities:

- Job Fairs and Campus Recruitment Drives
- Startup and MSME Hiring Events
- Industry Interaction and Guest Lecture Sessions
- Corporate Networking Events
- Placement Support and Referral Activities
- Career Development and Alumni Engagement Events

Gyantrika shall make reasonable efforts to facilitate connections with industry partners; however, it does not guarantee placement or employment of any Student.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF GYANTRIKA FOUNDATION

Gyantrika shall, during the term of this MoU,

- Design, develop and deliver internship and training programs.
- Provide qualified trainers, mentors and resource persons.
- Develop project-based and industry-oriented learning modules and content.
- Conduct assessments, evaluations and feedback mechanisms.
- Issue certificates to eligible Students upon successful completion.
- Facilitate industry interactions and corporate networking, wherever feasible.
- Support employability enhancement and placement preparation activities.
- Ensure quality standards in program delivery and materials.
- Maintain program records and share relevant reports with the Institution.
- Designate a nodal point of contact for coordination with the Institution.
- Comply with applicable laws, regulations and data protection requirements.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE INSTITUTION

The Institution shall, during the term of this MoU:

- Facilitate and encourage student participation in Programs.
- Provide necessary infrastructure, classrooms or online access, wherever applicable.
- Coordinate batch scheduling, timetables and administrative logistics.
- Nominate one or more Faculty Coordinators to liaise with Gyantrika.
- Support communication, promotion and awareness of Programs among students.
- Ensure discipline, attendance and active participation of Students.
- Obtain necessary internal approvals, if required under institutional regulations.
- Provide accurate student data/records as required for Program administration.
- Promptly communicate grievances, issues or feedback to Gyantrika's nodal contact.
- Comply with applicable laws, regulations and data protection requirements.

TECHNOLOGY PARTNER

OLatus Systems Private Limited shall act as the Technology Partner for the delivery of technology-enabled Programs under this MoU. The engagement of the Technology Partner is the sole responsibility of Gyantrika and shall not create any direct rights or obligations between the Institution and OLatus Systems Private Limited. Gyantrika shall remain liable for the performance and conduct of its Technology Partner in relation to the Programs.

CERTIFICATION

Students successfully fulfilling the requirements of a Program may receive the following certificates, as applicable:

- Internship Completion Certificate
- Training Completion Certificate
- Project Participation Certificate
- Skill Development Certificate
- Assessment Certificate

All certificates shall be issued by Gyantrika Foundation. The Institution shall not issue certificates on behalf of Gyantrika without prior written authorization. Eligibility criteria for certification shall be communicated by Gyantrika prior to the commencement of each Program.

FINANCIAL TERMS

12.1 Internship Fee: ₹499/- (Rupees Four Hundred Ninety-Nine Only) per Student per Program, unless otherwise mutually agreed in writing.

12.2 The batch structure, payment modality, schedule and operational arrangements shall be determined by mutual written agreement before commencement of each Program.

12.3 Specialized programs, advanced certifications, industry-sponsored programs or customized training modules may be separately priced through a written addendum to this MoU.

12.4 All fees shall be quoted inclusive/exclusive of applicable taxes (including GST) as communicated in writing before commencement of each Program.

12.5 Payments shall be made within the timelines stipulated in the applicable program addendum. Delayed payments may attract interest at the rate mutually agreed upon.

12.6 In the event of cancellation of a Program by the Institution after batch formation, a reasonable cancellation fee may be levied, the quantum of which shall be pre-agreed in writing.

12.7 Neither Party shall be liable to pay the other any fee, remuneration or compensation except as expressly agreed in writing.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

13.1 All Intellectual Property created, developed or brought into the collaboration by Gyantrika (including curriculum, training materials, software tools, platforms and content) shall remain the exclusive property of Gyantrika or its licensors.

13.2 All Intellectual Property created, developed or brought into the collaboration by the Institution shall remain the exclusive property of the Institution.

13.3 This MoU does not grant either Party any license, right or interest in the Intellectual Property of the other Party, except as strictly necessary to perform obligations under this MoU.

13.4 Student projects and research outputs developed during Programs shall be owned as per guidelines agreed upon in writing prior to commencement of the concerned Program.

13.5 Neither Party shall use the name, logo, trademark or brand of the other Party for any commercial or public purpose without prior written consent.

CONFIDENTIALITY

14.1 Each Party agrees to maintain strict confidentiality of all Confidential Information received from the other Party and shall not disclose such information to any third party without the prior written consent of the disclosing Party.

14.2 Each Party shall use Confidential Information solely for the purposes of this MoU and shall protect it with the same degree of care it uses to protect its own confidential information, but no less than reasonable care.

14.3 The obligations under this Clause shall survive the expiration or termination of this MoU for a period of Three (3) years.

14.4 The confidentiality obligations shall not apply to information that: (a) is or becomes publicly available through no fault of the receiving Party; (b) was independently developed by the receiving Party; (c) was lawfully obtained from a third party without restriction; or (d) is required to be disclosed by law or court order (with prompt notice to the disclosing Party).

DATA PROTECTION & PRIVACY

- 15.1 Both Parties shall comply with applicable data protection and privacy laws of India, including but not limited to the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023, as amended from time to time.
- 15.2 Student personal data collected for the purposes of Program administration shall be used strictly for such purposes and shall not be shared with unauthorized third parties.
- 15.3 Each Party shall implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect personal data from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction.
- 15.4 Upon termination of this MoU, each Party shall return or securely destroy the personal data of the other Party's students and personnel, unless required to be retained by law.

INNOVATION HUB DEVELOPMENT

The Parties may collaborate for the establishment and development of an Innovation Hub, Innovation Cell, Entrepreneurship Development Cell, Startup Support Centre, Innovation & Skill Development Centre or similar ecosystem initiatives within the Institution.

The Innovation Hub may undertake the following activities:

- Innovation Promotion Activities
- Startup Awareness Programs
- Entrepreneurship Development Programs
- Hackathons and Ideathons
- Innovation Challenges and Competitions
- Industry Interaction and Expert Lecture Series
- Startup Mentorship and Incubation Support Sessions
- Research Commercialization Support
- Government Scheme Awareness Programs
- Skill and Innovation Events

The Parties acknowledge that the establishment of an Innovation Hub shall require separate detailed agreements covering governance, funding, intellectual property, operations and long-term development. This MoU shall serve as a non-binding expression of intent in this regard. No financial commitment or operational obligation relating to the Innovation Hub shall arise solely from this Clause.

REPRESENTATIONS & WARRANTIES

Each Party represents and warrants to the other Party that:

- It is duly constituted, registered and authorized to enter into and perform this MoU.
- This MoU has been duly authorized, executed and constitutes a valid and binding obligation.
- The execution and performance of this MoU do not violate any applicable law, regulation, order or agreement.
- All information provided by it in connection with this MoU is true, accurate and complete in all material respects.
- It shall conduct its activities under this MoU in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

18.1 Neither Party shall be liable to the other for any indirect, consequential, incidental, special or punitive damages arising out of or in connection with this MoU, even if such Party has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

18.2 Gyantrika does not guarantee placement, employment or any specific outcome for Students participating in Programs under this MoU.

18.3 The total aggregate liability of either Party under this MoU shall not exceed the total fees actually paid under this MoU in the twelve (12) months preceding the event giving rise to the claim.

18.4 Each Party shall indemnify and hold harmless the other Party from any claims, losses, damages or expenses arising from its own gross negligence, wilful misconduct or breach of this MoU.

FORCE MAJEURE

Neither Party shall be liable for any failure or delay in the performance of its obligations under this MoU to the extent that such failure or delay is caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, natural disasters, epidemic, pandemic, government-imposed restrictions, war, civil unrest, or failure of utilities or communications infrastructure ("Force Majeure Event").

The affected Party shall promptly notify the other Party of the Force Majeure Event and its expected duration. Both Parties shall use reasonable endeavours to mitigate the impact of such event. If a Force Majeure Event continues for more than Sixty (60) days, either Party may terminate this MoU by providing Thirty (30) days' written notice.

VALIDITY & RENEWAL

20.1 This MoU shall come into effect on the date of execution by both Parties and shall remain valid for a period of Five (5) Years from such date, unless terminated earlier.

20.2 This MoU may be renewed upon expiration by mutual written agreement of the Parties, on such terms and conditions as may be agreed at the time of renewal.

20.3 Any renewal shall be evidenced by a written addendum or fresh memorandum executed by both Parties.

TERMINATION

21.1 Either Party may terminate this MoU without cause by providing Ninety (90) days' prior written notice to the other Party.

21.2 Either Party may terminate this MoU immediately by written notice if the other Party commits a material breach of this MoU and fails to remedy such breach within Thirty (30) days of receipt of written notice specifying the breach.

21.3 Either Party may terminate this MoU immediately by written notice if the other Party becomes insolvent, is wound up, or a receiver or administrator is appointed over its assets.

21.4 Upon termination, all ongoing internship, training or student activities already formally initiated and confirmed shall be allowed to continue to completion unless the terminating Party otherwise agrees in writing.

21.5 Termination shall not affect any rights or obligations accrued prior to the effective date of termination. Clauses relating to confidentiality, intellectual property, dispute resolution and governing law shall survive termination.

- 22.1 The Parties shall attempt to resolve any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in connection with this MoU through good faith negotiations within Thirty (30) days of written notice by one Party to the other specifying the nature of the dispute.
- 22.2 If the dispute is not resolved through negotiations, either Party may refer the matter to mediation before a mutually agreed mediator. The costs of mediation shall be shared equally.
- 22.3 If the dispute remains unresolved after mediation, it shall be referred to and finally resolved by binding arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (as amended).
- 22.4 The arbitration shall be conducted by a Sole Arbitrator mutually appointed by the Parties. If the Parties are unable to agree on the appointment within Fifteen (15) days of a written request, the Arbitrator shall be appointed in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
- 22.5 The seat and venue of arbitration shall be Guwahati, Assam. The proceedings shall be conducted in the English language. The arbitral award shall be final and binding on both Parties.

GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION

This MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Subject to the dispute resolution provisions herein, the Courts at Guwahati, Assam shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any matter arising from or in connection with this MoU.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 24.1 **Entire Agreement:** This MoU constitutes the entire understanding between the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations and agreements, whether oral or written.
- 24.2 **Amendments:** Any amendment, modification or supplement to this MoU shall be valid only if made in writing and duly signed by authorized representatives of both Parties.
- 24.3 **Notices:** All notices and communications under this MoU shall be in writing and delivered by hand, registered post or email (with delivery confirmation) to the addresses specified by the Parties. Notices shall be deemed received upon actual delivery or acknowledgement of email, as applicable.
- 24.4 **Severability:** If any provision of this MoU is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
- 24.5 **Waiver:** The failure of either Party to enforce any right under this MoU shall not constitute a waiver of that right.
- 24.6 **Non-Exclusivity:** This MoU is non-exclusive. Either Party may enter into similar arrangements with other institutions or organizations.
- 24.7 **Relationship of Parties:** This MoU does not create a partnership, joint venture, agency, employment or franchise relationship between the Parties. Neither Party shall have authority to bind the other.
- 24.8 **Counterparts:** This MoU may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
- 24.9 **Language:** This MoU is executed in the English language. In the event of any translation, the English version shall prevail.
